CR has reviewed the CoP, nothing included on self-connects, should that be included or should it be elsewhere? MG replied that should be covered, not explicitly but included in "Part C-5. Accreditation and Authorisation of ICPs/DNOs" of the Competition in Connections Code of Practice. The competency of ICPs to undertake operational works is part of NERS Requirements and Accreditations. The criteria for this process should be set by the DNO.



CR asked a question on the legal process, where an ICP is installing an asset, it is up to the ICP to be aware of the restrictions on the route and highlight to the DNO, is that the correct interpretation? Group agreed that is correct, it is up to the ICP to have the correct agreements in place for any route.
